

What is the benefit of having a water filter in my fridge?

The GE Smartwater MWF removes the following impurities from your drinking water -

- 99% of Lead, 93% of Mercury, 99% of asbestos, 96% of Benzene, 99% of P-Dichlorobenzene, more than 99% of Cysts, 94 - 99% of herbicides, 93 - 99% insecticides, 96% Chlorine and 99% of particles of rust, sand, dirt and sediment (0.5 to 1 micron in size).
- It is also reported to improve the clarity of the water by up to 98%.
- This filter **does NOT remove Fluoride**.
- Overall, it provides better tasting and smelling water with improved clarity.
- Changing the filter regularly in your ice/water refrigerator also reduces the build-up of scale in your ice-making mechanism thereby reducing the need for costly services.

The GE MWF is tested and certified by NSF International to meet or exceed NSF/ANSI Standards 42 & 53.

How do I install my new water filter?

Installing your new water filter:

- Twist the old filter a half-turn counterclockwise.
- Pull the filter straight down and discard (the water will shut off automatically).
- Fill the new filter with water (you can use the cold water tap on your kitchen sink).
- Push the new filter up into the fridge until it stops.
- Twist the filter a half-turn clockwise.
- Reset your "change filter" light (if your fridge has one).

Resetting your "change filter" light:

- Press and hold the reset water filter button on the dispenser for 3 seconds.
